



Operation Classroom Health Kits

Health kits are being collected for *Operation Classroom* and need to be available by May 13. Health kits provide basic necessities and are used as learning tools in personal hygiene, literacy, nutrition and cooking classes. When people gain the knowledge and materials to maintain personal hygiene, their overall health improves.

- ◆ 1 bath towel (average size)
- ◆ 1 washcloth
- ◆ 1 tube toothpaste (4.5 oz. or larger)
- ◆ 1 toothbrush (in original wrapping)
- ◆ 1 bar soap (bath size—in original wrapping)
- ◆ 1 can talc powder or bottle of body lotion (put into small Ziploc bag)
- ◆ 1 bottle multi-vitamins (expiration date no earlier than March 2013)
- ◆ 1 bottle Tylenol (expiration date no earlier than March 2013)
- ◆ 1 small bottle hand sanitizer (put into a small Ziploc bag)



To pack the kit, place all other items onto the bath towel. Fold up so that everything will be secure inside. Then place the bundle inside a 2-gallon Ziploc, other plastic bag secured with tape, or a plastic storage container.

- ◆ First aid supplies
- ◆ Softsoap liquid hand soap
- ◆ Backpacks
- ◆ Copy paper
